With the new cashless fare system, customers will be able to purchase fares, manage accounts, and plan trips seamlessly via a mobile app or smartcard—eliminating the need for cash transactions on board.

The new One-Day Pass allows unlimited rides on all fixed route buses for a full-service day, making it easier and more affordable for riders who need to travel multiple times throughout the day.

Please note: All fare purchases, including the new One-Day Pass, must be made online via the Modeshift app, website, or the administrative office. Passes will not be available for purchase on buses.
